2020 Scholarship Program

The Greene County Community Fund announces the 2020 **Greene County Community Fund Scholarship Awards Program.** Under the Program, four (4) \$1000 scholarships will be awarded to seniors attending Greene County Tech, Paragould, Marmaduke and Crowley's Ridge Academy High Schools in Greene County, AR. There will be one scholarship awarded per school.

To be eligible, Applicants must meet the following requirements for consideration

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteerism in the community.
- * Be a resident of Greene County and attend school at one of the four Greene County High Schools.
- * Applicants must plan to attend a two (2)-year community college/technical school or four (4)-year college or university.
- * Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- * Applications must be received by the Greene County Community Fund no later than February 28, 2020.
- * <u>A complete application packet is required for consideration.</u> Late or incomplete applications may not be considered.

Scholarship funds will be paid during the month of **September 2020**—Funds are disbursed directly to the institution and may be used for costs of tuition, books, room/board, fees, and other college expenses. If chosen as a recipient, \$500 will be awarded in the fall and spring semesters. The fall semester scholarship funds will be issued to the college or university upon receiving a certificate of enrollment for, which includes the Student ID number and Financial Aid Office address. Upon completion of the fall semester, a transcript demonstrating a C or better average and verification of enrollment for spring semester which includes the Student ID number and Financial Aid Office address must be submitted to the GCCF office in order for funds to be sent to the institution for the spring semester no later than **February 1, 2021**.

The applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by the GCCF Scholarship Committee. The scholarships will be awarded at your schools senior awards day, date determined by each individual school.

- Scholarship Application: Completed scholarship application from Greene County Community Fund Community Service Scholarship.
- Essay: Provide a short, personal essay about how your community service came about and what being a volunteer has taught you. Are there any causes or organizations that especially interest you? Finally, discuss any challenges you have dealt with and overcome and how this will help you succeed in college and beyond.
- o Other: Answer briefly "Why you should be chosen to receive this scholarship and what impact you would like to make in your community?"
- o Statement of GPA: Enclose a copy of your unofficial high school transcript.
- Two recommendation letters: Provide two letters from teachers, employers, volunteer leaders, church leaders, etc., who can tell us about your personal qualities and work ethics. Recommendation letters from family members are not accepted.
- o Amount awarded in scholarships to date.

*This Scholarship will be awarded to individuals that best fulfills the following areas:

- 1. Holds a valued place within their community that exhibits a positive impact.
- 2. Investing time in Leadership opportunities within their community/school.
- 3. Over all, well-diverse person who takes time to make a difference by involvement.
